SUBJECT: Port of Jacksonville Centralized Importer Security Filing Seminar

Purpose:

This bulletin is to inform the Jacksonville trade community of a trade meeting to discuss the implementation of the Importer Security Filing requirements, which is also referred to as the 10 + 2 rule.

Background:

The Importer Security Filing and additional carrier requirements were published as an Interim Final Rule (IFR) on November 25, 2008. They became effective on January 26, 2009. The IFR requires additional data elements be transmitted to Customs and Border Protection (CBP) as a part of the importation process. A 12 month delayed compliance period began on the effective date to allow industry time to comply with the new requirements. The compliance period will be drawing to a close on January 26, 2010.

CBP would like to invite members of the trade community to attend a trade meeting on October 21, 2009 from 12:30 to 4:00. The meeting will be held in the JAXPORT Conference Room at 2831 Talleyrand Ave., Jacksonville, FL. This meeting will provide attendees an opportunity to discuss the new requirements.
