BRADLEY COMES FROM DETROIT AND HAS 13 YRS. EXPERIENCE. HE SPOKE
BRIEFLY ABOUT 520(D) CLAIMS BEING UTILIZED CORRECTLY.

PHIL THEN INTRODUCED GARY CHWAST WHO IS WITH ICE (IMMIGRATION &
CUSTOMS ENFORCMENT).

GARY SPOKE ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING VIGILANT AND REPORTING
ANYTHING SUSPICIOUS THAT WE IN THE TRADE MAY SEE. HE SAID THAT THERE
WAS A LOCAL CASE THAT STARTED WITH A BROKER BEING SUSPICIOUS OF A
P.O.A. THAT HAS RESULTED IN SEVERAL ARRESTS BEING MADE. INFORMATION

CAROLYN RYALS W/FDA WAS THEN INTRODUCED. SHE THEN INTRODUCED
ROBERT HATCH WHO IS NOW A JAX IMPORT INSPECTOR WORKING WITH
CAROLYN. HIS PHONE EXTENSION IS #109. CAROLYN ALSO ADVISED THAT

MIKE GETCHELL/JMTX HARBOR SAFETY CHAIR THEN SPOKE. HE ADVISED THAT THE HARBOR DEEPENING IS IN PROCESS AND THE RIGHT WHALE SEASON WAS SUCCESSFUL WITH NO FATALITIES.

DOUG CAMPBELL W THE COAST GUARD REMINDED US THAT WE ARE IN THE HURRICANE SEASON. THE TRADE WILL BE KEPT UPDATED VIA THE JMTX WEBSITE SHOULD WE ENCOUNTER ANY WEATHER RELATED ISSUES FOR THE JAX. AREA.

GETCHEL ACOSTA W/CBP WAS INTRODUCED AS THE JAX RLF COORDINATOR. SHARON & LYNN WATERS ARE WORKING TO GET A LIST OF THE CURRENT RLF COORDINATORS FOR ALL THE PORTS AND WILL PASS ON TO THE COMMITTEE.
